President's Report

At last, for 2021! Sunday the 21st of February was the first occasion on which our Club Members could meet together socially since 16th February 2020 at the Melbourne Gun Club due to Covid-19.

We took this opportunity to conduct our Annual General Meeting for the year to 30th June 2020 to report to the members on the mandatory requirements of the Associations Reform Act 2012 (we had written approval from Consumer Affairs Victoria to convene the meeting outside the requirement of the 5 months to the end of the financial year).

We only managed to conduct 3 shoots prior to the lockdown (2 in 2019 and 1 in 2020) which enabled the Club to return a very modest net profit of \$229 for the year. A copy of the financial statement tabled to all the members present is on page 15 & 16 for your review.

The existing Committee was elected unopposed, and Rod Fox, who joined the club on the 29th June 2009, was nominated and elevated to the Committee.

There was an item of business for which prior notice had been tabled relating to conducting a shoot at Kilmore Field and Game and after much spirited discussion it was agreed by the substantial majority of members that a shoot should be planned even though the nomination cost for a 50 target event would need to be substantially increased (from \$35 to \$50) to cover any likelihood of any loss being incurred by the club. There will be more on this proposal at a later stage when negotiations with both Field and Game Aust. and Kilmore F&G have agreed to the timing.

The Meeting concluded and the following long term committee members were awarded with life memberships for their 15 years of support in the administration of the club. Max Lee, joined 17th February 2002, committee member since November 2006; Greg Menzies, joined 8th February 2002, committee member since November 2006; John Rowe, joined 1st April 2003, committee member since 2006.

Then followed the planned 50 target event which attracted 72 nominations. Bright sunny day, great target selection and ground set up thanks to Melbourne Gun Club, and a wide selection of food and drink available from the canteen, thanks to Gerald, wife and daughters.

Licencing and Regulations Division (LRD) Change of Address:

It is a requirement of your licence or permit that you notify the Licensing and Regulation Division in writing within 14 days of any change. Penalties apply for failing to notify in writing of a change of certain details.

If you wish to change any of the following, you will need to complete a change of details form online.

- Address (residential, business and single storage address).
- Employer (private security only).
- Personal details (date of birth, phone number, email).

If you ordinarily reside outside of Victoria, you cannot hold a Victorian Firearm Licence. Instead, you must hold a Firearm Licence issued by the state or territory in which you ordinarily reside. Interstate residents may hold a Victorian Longarm or Handgun Licence, if the licence is required for work purposes in the state of Victoria.

Change of Gender/Sex

Please contact the LRD to change your gender/sex and be aware of the following requirements:

- A medical report indicating that a course of treatment is being undertaken in preparation for gender re-assignment, or surgical reassignment has taken place.
- A certified copy of their 'Recognised Details Certificate' or equivalent

provided by Births Deaths and Marriages as supplied.

Change of Name:

- A change of name certificate issued by the Victorian Registry of Births, Deaths and Marriages.
- Your full birth certificate (including the schedule of all names changes).
- Your marriage certificate.

Change of Storage Address

If you intend to store your firearms at multiple ordinary storage addresses you must send an updated firearms list to the Licensing and Regulation Division via email and provide the details of each firearm (including serial numbers) and allocate an ordinary storage address for each one.

You may request a list of your registered firearms to be emailed to you from the Licensing and Regulation Division which you can review and return with your change of details form.

Lost, stolen or damaged licence

If you lose your licence or it is stolen or damaged, you must:

Notify the Licensing and Regulation Division via email as soon as you are aware of your missing licence. Complete a duplicate licence form and send it back via post or email to the Licensing and Regulation Division.

Once your request has been processed, you will receive instructions for making payment and having your photo taken for a new licence card by post.




